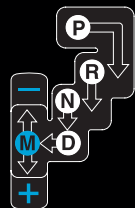

SPORT A/T MANUAL-SHIFT MODE

THE SPORT A/T MANUAL-SHIFT MODE GIVES YOU THE FEEL OF DRIVING A MANUAL TRANSMISSION BY ALLOWING YOU TO MANUALLY SHIFT TO CONTROL ENGINE RPM AND TORQUE WHEN MORE CONTROL IS DESIRED.



TO USE MANUAL-SHIFT MODE:

Shift lever from **D** to **M**.

NOTE: Changing to manual mode can be done while driving the vehicle.

TO SHIFT DOWN TO A LOWER GEAR:

Tap shift lever forward (–) once.

TO SHIFT UP TO A HIGHER GEAR:

Tap shift lever back (+) once.

The transmission will automatically adjust how and when it shifts gears based on road conditions and your driving style. The transmission may stay in a lower gear longer than usual when going up or down hills or driving around corners. This feature gives you better control and a more connected driving experience.

REMOTE KEYLESS ENTRY SYSTEM



TRUNK

Push and hold to open trunk.

PANIC ALARM

Push for one second or more to activate alarm.

Push Lock, Unlock, Trunk or Panic Alarm to turn alarm off.

UNLOCK

Push once to unlock driver's door.

Push twice (within three seconds) to unlock all doors.

LOCK

Push once to lock all doors.

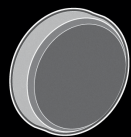
Push twice (within five seconds) for horn sound verification that all doors are locked.

RELEASE BUTTON

Push to extend key.

Push and fold to retract key.

POWER DRIVER'S SEAT CONTROLS



LUMBAR ADJUSTMENT

Rotate clockwise to increase support and counterclockwise to decrease support.



SLIDE/TILT SWITCH

Seat can be moved back and forth, raised, lowered or tilted with this control.



RECLINE SWITCH

Push forward or backward to adjust seatback angle.

PORTABLE AUDIO PLAYER INTEGRATION



NOTE: A 3.5 mm audio cable is needed to connect your portable audio player to the AUX jack.


YOUR VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED WITH AN AUXILIARY INPUT JACK THAT WILL ALLOW YOU TO PLAY YOUR PORTABLE AUDIO PLAYER THROUGH THE VEHICLE'S AUDIO SYSTEM. LEARN HOW TO USE THE SYSTEM WHEN PARKED, AND DO NOT LET IT DISTRACT YOU WHILE DRIVING.

1. Locate the AUX jack inside the center console under the armrest.
2. Plug a 3.5 mm audio cable into both the portable audio player and the AUX jack. Turn portable audio player on.
3. Turn the vehicle's audio system on.
4. Push the AUX button on the audio system OR push the MODE button on the steering wheel controls until AUX is displayed.
5. Use the portable audio player controls to play music.




IMPORTANT: Set the volume level on your portable audio player to the highest level before distortion starts, then adjust the volume on the car's audio system.

PAIRING YOUR BLUETOOTH OR AUDIO DEVICE

VOICE PAIRING

1. PUSH AND RELEASE (wait for beep) THE  BUTTON ON THE STEERING WHEEL.
2. FROM MAIN MENU SAY, "SETUP; PAIRING OPTIONS."
3. SAY, "PAIR."
4. SAY A FOUR-DIGIT CODE (i.e., "1, 2, 3, 4").
5. PLACE PHONE IN DISCOVERY MODE; IF NECESSARY, CONSULT YOUR PHONE'S MANUAL OR GO TO MAZDAUSA.COM/BLUETOOTH. SELECT MODEL, BLUETOOTH, AND FOLLOW SCREEN PROMPTS.
6. AFTER PHONE IS RECOGNIZED, YOU WILL BE PROMPTED TO NAME THE PAIRED PHONE.
7. PAIRING COMPLETED.

MAKE/RECEIVE A HANDS-FREE CALL

-  BUTTON TO MAKE/RECEIVE/SWAP (during call interruption) A CALL.
-  BUTTON TO END/REJECT A CALL.
-  BUTTON TO SKIP VOICE GUIDANCE (for speeding up your operation).

NOTE:

For safety reasons, you cannot pair a phone while driving.

Before pairing your cell phone or audio device, it is recommended that you refer to its manual for steps to turn on Bluetooth and perform pairing.

IMPORTANT: Set the volume level on your cell phone or audio device to the highest level before distortion starts, then adjust the volume on the audio system.

If your compatible Bluetooth phone is equipped with a music player and supports the Bluetooth profile A2DP, your phone will pair for both hands-free calling as well as Bluetooth audio during the pairing process and will be considered one unit. Please refer to the owner's manual for complete details on how to pair up to seven Bluetooth phones and audio devices, and how to use the built-in tutorial and other important safety information.

When Using Bluetooth Audio Function: The sound quality of Bluetooth streaming audio varies depending on the device, even when recorded with a recommended bit rate of at least 128 kbps.

AUTO RE-CONNECT: On engine start, the last-connected device will be automatically re-connected. The system is operable several seconds after engine start.

POWER DRIVER'S SEAT CONTROLS

NOT BEING IN YOUR OWN VEHICLE CAN DISRUPT YOUR ROUTINE. SO HERE ARE SOME HELPFUL REMINDERS BEFORE YOU RETURN YOUR MAZDA6.

DON'T FORGET:

- YOUR PHONE: Mazda6's Bluetooth capabilities free up your hands and your worries.
- YOUR CDS: Having up to 6 CDs conveniently at your fingertips means not having to switch them out as often.
- YOUR MP3 PLAYER: No that wasn't a psychic radio station playing all of your favorite songs. Also, don't forget your audio cable.
- PERSONAL ITEMS: With all that space and all those compartments, it's easy to forget the small but important things.
- CHECK THE TRUNK: Did you know the Mazda6 has the largest trunk in its class? Don't forget to look for larger belongings there, too.
- FILL THE GAS TANK: Getting great gas mileage makes frequenting the pump a distant memory.
